ORDERED, that the application is granted; and it is further

ORDERED, that the remaining portion of the claim of the New York Property/Casualty Insurance Security Fund in the amount of \$7,109 for both expenses and losses the fund incurred and paid from April 1, 2016 to June 30, 2016 is approved;

ORDERED, that the Liquidator's report on the status of and request to close the Liquidation Proceeding of CCIC and financial transactions delineated in such report are approved; and it is further


ORDERED, that the Liquidator is authorized to continue paying administrative expenses, including such expenses for the closing of the Liquidation Proceeding; and it is further

ORDERED, that the NYLB is authorized to continue, after the termination of the Liquidation Proceeding, to receive and disburse assets to those creditors of CCIC with allowed Class two claims who are eligible to share in a *pro-rata* distribution and to pay any and all administrative expenses incurred in connection with the collection and disbursement of any such assets.
