**IN THE MATTER OF THE LIQUIDATION OF
HEALTH REPUBLIC INSURANCE OF NEW YORK, CORP.
Supreme Court County of New York

The Superintendent of Financial Services of the State of New York as liquidator (“Liquidator”) of Health Republic Insurance of New York, Corp. (“Health Republic”) has made an application to the Supreme Court of the State of New York, County of New York (“Court”) seeking an order:

confirming that, notwithstanding the existence of an anti-assignment provision in a Health Republic insurance policy, the Liquidator may, where appropriate, make an allowed payment directly to a health care provider for the costs of covered services, whether the claim for payment was made by the policyholder, the health care provider, or both.

The Court has set February 17, 2017, at 10:00 a.m. as the date and time for any interested parties to appear before the Court at the Courthouse, 60 Centre Street, New York, New York 10007, Room 438, and show cause why the requested relief should not be granted. If you wish to object to the Liquidator’s application, you must serve upon the Liquidator a written statement setting forth your objection and all supporting documentation by February 10, 2017, at the following address:
