A motion having regularly come on to be heard before this Court on the 9th day of September, 2011, for an Order approving and confirming the final report ("Final Report") on the Ancillary Receivership of Integrity Insurance Company ("Integrity") by the Superintendent of Insurance of the State of New York as Ancillary Receiver (the "Ancillary Receiver") of Integrity and for termination of said proceeding;

NOW, upon reading the Final Report, dated June 28, 2011, by Dennis J. Hayes, Special Deputy Superintendent (the "Special Deputy") and Agent of the Ancillary Receiver with due proof of service by overnight mail thereof upon Richard L. White, Deputy Liquidator of Integrity Insurance Company, 625 From Road, Suite 3, Paramus, New Jersey, the Verified Petition of the Special Deputy in support of said motion, and due deliberation having been had thereon, and upon the decision of this Court;

NOW, on application of John Pearson Kelly, Esq., Attorney for the Ancillary Receiver, it is

ORDERED, that the petition to approve the Final Report is granted; and it is further

ORDERED, that the within ancillary receivership proceeding is terminated and closed and that the Ancillary Receiver of Integrity, his predecessors and successors in office, their agents, attorneys and employees are released and discharged from any and all liability as to all matters embraced in the within proceeding and from any and all further liability in the ancillary receivership of Integrity;

ORDERED, that the New York Liquidation Bureau be authorized to receive and disburse to the New York Property/Casualty Insurance Security Fund ("P/C Fund") any future distributions from the Superintendent of Insurance of the State of New Jersey as Permanent Receiver of Integrity that are owing to the P/C Fund without further application to this Court;

ORDERED, that the Ancillary Receiver is authorized and directed to destroy or otherwise dispose of any and all of the books, files, records and other property of Integrity, without further order of the Court.


