NOW, on application of John Pearson Kelly, attorney for the Liquidator and after due deliberation having been had thereon it is;

ORDERED, that the application is granted; and it is further

ORDERED, that June 30, 2017 is the Bar Date for the submission to the Liquidator of all claims and documents supporting those claims against PLICA or its insureds, including claims reportable under any extended reporting period endorsements of policies issued by PLICA, other than the Liquidator's claims for administrative expenses, after which date, no new claims or evidence of claims shall be accepted by the Liquidator.
