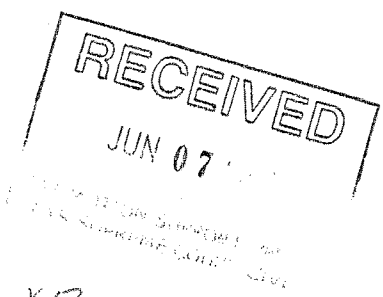

ORDERED, that the Report and the financial transactions delineated therein are approved, and it is further

ORDERED, that the within Conservation Proceeding is terminated and closed, and it is further

ORDERED, the Conservator, his predecessors and successors in office, agents, attorneys and employees are released and discharged from any and all liability arising from their acts and omissions in connection with the Conservation Proceeding; and it is further

ORDERED, that the Conservator is authorized and directed to destroy or otherwise dispose of any and all books, files, records and other property of United Capitol without further order of this Court.


