Linda A. Lacewell, Superintendent of Financial Services of the State of New York, for an Order of Appointment as Ancillary Receiver of

BEDIVERE INSURANCE COMPANY.

Upon the reading and filing of the annexed verified petition ("Verified Petition") of Linda A. Lacewell, Superintendent of Financial Services of the State of New York ("Superintendent"), duly verified on the 18th day of May 2021, and the affidavit of Joan Riddell, Deputy Chief Insurance Examiner, Property Bureau, New York State Department of Financial Services, sworn to on the 27th day of April 2021;

NOW, on motion of Letitia James, Attorney General of the State of New York, attorney for the Superintendent, and after due deliberation having been had thereon;

LET, Jessica K. Altman, Insurance Commissioner of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, as the duly-appointed Liquidator of Bedivere Insurance Company ("Bedivere") or any of her delegees and all creditors, claimants, and interested persons located in the State of

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> New York show cause before this Court at IAS Part 36 Room 210, thereof, at the Courthouse located at 71 MONUS Street in the County, City and State of New York, on the 16 day of UML, 2021, at 15 o'clock in the A.m., or as soon thereafter as counsel can be heard ("Return Date"), why an order, substantially in the form attached as Exhibit "1" to the Verified Petition ("Order"), should not be made, pursuant to Article 74 of the New York Insurance Law ("Insurance Law"), inter alia: (1) commencing a New York ancillary receivership proceeding for Bedivere and appointing the Superintendent and her successors in office ancillary receiver of Bedivere ("Ancillary Receiver"); (2) vesting the Ancillary Receiver with all rights and obligations granted to and imposed upon her pursuant to Insurance Law Article 74; (3) finding that the material provisions of the March 11, 2021, order of the Commonwealth Court of Pennsylvania placing Bedivere into liquidation ("Liquidation Order") including, but not limited to, the injunctions, restrictions, and directions set forth in paragraphs 7, 13, 14, and 15, apply to this ancillary receivership proceeding; (4) finding that in accordance with Insurance Law § 7412(a) the claims bar date of December 31, 2021, established by the procedures set forth in the Liquidation Order, applies to this ancillary receivership proceeding and all New York claims under Bedivere policies, and evidence supporting such claims must be submitted to the Ancillary Receiver by December 31, 2021, and if not submitted by that date shall be barred; (5) permanently enjoining and restraining all persons from commencing or prosecuting any actions, lawsuits, or proceedings in the State of New York against Bedivere, the Superintendent as Ancillary Receiver or as administrator of the New York security funds, the New York Liquidation Bureau, and their employees, attorneys, or agents, with respect to this proceeding or in the discharge of their duties; (6) enjoining and restraining all parties to actions. lawsuits, and special or other proceedings against insureds of Bedivere or in which Bedivere is

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obligated to defend an insured or provide a defense to a party pursuant to an insurance policy from obtaining any judgment or proceeding with any discovery, court proceedings or other litigation tasks or procedures, including, but not limited to, conferences, trials, applications for judgment or proceedings on settlement or judgment, for a period of 180 days from the date of entry of the Order; (7) enjoining and restraining all persons who have first party policyholder loss claims against Bedivere in the State of New York from presenting and filing claims with the Ancillary Receiver for a period of 90 days from the date the Ancillary Receivership Order is signed; (8) extending judicial immunity to the Superintendent in her capacity as Ancillary Receiver of Bedivere and as administrator of the New York security funds, her successors in office, the New York Liquidation Bureau, and their agents and employees, for any cause of action of any nature against them, individually or jointly, for any act or omission when acting in good faith, in accordance with the orders of this Court, or in the performance of their duties pursuant to Insurance Law Articles 74 and 76 and Article 6-A of the New York Workers' Compensation Law; and (9) granting such other and further relief as the Court may deem just and proper;

AND sufficient cause having been shown therefor, it is hereby

ORDERED, that service of this Order to Show Cause and its supporting papers shall be deemed good and proper service if served by: (i) overnight delivery to Laura Lyon Slaymaker, Deputy Insurance Commissioner, Office of Liquidations, Rehabilitations and Special Funds, representing Jessica K. Altman, Insurance Commissioner of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in her capacity as Liquidator of Bedivere Insurance Company at 901 North 7<sup>th</sup> Street, Harrisburg, Pennsylvania, 17102 at least 3 days before the Return Date; and

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(ii) posting on the Internet web page maintained by the New York Liquidation Bureau at http://www.nylb.org at least 15 days prior to the Return Date; and it is further

ORDERED, that any answering papers in support of or in opposition to this application ("Answering Papers") be served so as to be received by the Superintendent at least 7 days prior to the Return Date, and that such service shall be made at the following addresses:

and that the Answering Papers be filed with this Court on or before the Return Date; and it is to file the file of the file of

ORDERED, that pursuant to Insurance Law § 7419(a), pending the determination of this application, Bedivere, its officers, directors, shareholders, members, trustees, agents, servants, employees, policyholders, attorneys, and managers, and all other persons, are hereby restrained, except as authorized by the Superintendent, from transacting Bedivere's business or disposing of Bedivere's property located in the State of New York, and all persons are restrained from wasting any of Bedivere's assets located in the State of New York; and it is further

ORDERED, that pursuant to New York Insurance Law § 7419(b), pending a *hearing* determination on this application, Bedivere, its officers, directors, shareholders, members, trustees, agents, servants, employees, attorneys, and managers, and all other persons are hereby restrained from obtaining preferences, judgments, attachments, or other liens, or making any levy


