**ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE**

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Based on the annexed November 13, 2023 affirmation of Yuanzhou Wu, an attorney for the New York Liquidation Bureau (the "Wu Affirmation"), the organization which carries out the duties of the Superintendent of Financial Services of the State of New York as liquidator (the "Liquidator") of Park Insurance Company ("Park"), and upon all other papers previously submitted and all proceedings heretofore had herein;

NOW, on motion of the Liquidator, and after due deliberation having been had thereon,

LET all claimants and all interested in the affairs of Park show cause before this Court at the IAS ~~Motion-Submission~~ <sup>14</sup> Part at the Courthouse located at 60 Centre Street, Room ~~130~~ <sup>432</sup>, New York, New York, 10013, via ~~videoconference (Microsoft Teams)~~ <sup>67</sup> submission only, on the 30th day of November, 2023 (the "Return Date") at     o'elock     m., or as soon thereafter as counsel can be heard, why an order, substantially in the form of the proposed order attached as Exhibit E to the Wu Affirmation, should not be made: (i) approving the Early Access, Disbursement, Reimbursement and Refunding Agreement for Park Insurance Company, attached as Exhibit A to the Wu Affirmation (the "Early Access Agreement"), and (ii) permitting the Liquidator to take

necessary steps to effect, carry out and consummate the Early Access Agreement, including making disbursements to the New York Public Motor Vehicle Security Fund in accordance with the terms and conditions of the Early Access Agreement;

AND, sufficient cause having been alleged therefore, and this Court having found the form and method of notice specified herein to be reasonable, it is hereby

ORDERED, that the Liquidator shall provide notice of this application by: (i) mailing this Order to Show Cause and its supporting papers by first class mail to: (a) David Axinn, Special Deputy Superintendent and Agent of the Superintendent of Financial Services as administrator of the New York Public Motor Vehicle Security Fund, 180 Maiden Ln., Floor 14, New York, NY 10038; (b) Adrienne A. Harris, Superintendent of Financial Services of the State of New York, New York State Department of Financial Services, 1 State Street, New York, NY 10004-1511; (ii) posting this Order to Show Cause and the papers in support of the application on the Internet web page maintained by the New York Liquidation Bureau at <http://www.nylb.org> on or before 11/22, 2023; and such service shall be deemed good and sufficient; and it is further

ORDERED, that answering papers, either in support of or in opposition to the relief sought herein ("Answering Papers"), be served on the Liquidator via email to [legal@nylb.org](mailto:legal@nylb.org) ~~as to be received at least seven (7) days prior to the Return Date, and any Answering Papers, together with an affidavit of service, shall be e-filed with the Court on the New York State Courts Electronic Filing System on or before the Return Date.~~
