Harris, Superintendent of Financial Services of the State of New York in her capacity as liquidator ("Liquidator") of Park Insurance Company ("Park"), and upon all other papers previously submitted and all proceedings heretofore had herein;

NOW, on motion of Stephanie Blattmachr, attorney for the Liquidator, and after due deliberation having been had thereon;

or their counsel

LET all claimants and parties interested in the affairs of Park appear and show cause before this Court at IAS Part 14, at the Courthouse located at 60 Centre Street, New York, New York, on on submission only the 21 day of April , 2022 ("Return Date"), at e'eloek me, or as soon thereafter as counsel can be heard, why an order substantially in the form of the proposed order annexed as Exhibit "1" to the Pisapia Aff. should not be made, pursuant to Article 74 of the New York

Insurance Law, inter alia: (i) establishing March 31, 2023 as the date by which all claims against Park, and all evidence in support of such claims, must be submitted to the Liquidator (the "Bar Date"), except that the Bar Date shall not apply to the Liquidator's claims for administrative expenses ("Admin Claims") or to claims for reimbursement submitted by the New York Property/Casualty Insurance Security Fund, the New York Public Motor Vehicle Liability Security Fund, or a guaranty fund in another state that covers claims against Park policies (collectively, "Fund Claims"), and that any claims, other than Admin Claims and Fund Claims, submitted after the Bar Date will be barred and discharged, (ii) requiring all claims, and all evidence supporting such claims, be filed using the electronic portal for the submission of claims located on the website www.nylbpoc.org on or before the Bar Date; and (iii) granting such other and further relief as the Court may deem proper and just.

AND, sufficient cause having been alleged therefor, and this Court having found the form and method of notice specified herein to be reasonable and appropriate under the circumstances, it is hereby

ORDERED, that the Liquidator shall provide notice of this application by (i) posting a copy of this Order to Show Cause and its supporting papers on the Legal Estates and Notices Section of the Internet web page maintained by the NYLB at http://www.nylb.org within five (5) days of the entered Order to Show Cause being posted to the New York State Courts Electronic Filing (NYSCEF) system; and (ii) publishing notice of this Order to Show Cause substantially in the form as the proposed notice attached as Exhibit "2" to the Pisapia Aff. in the New York Post, or a publication of similar circulation, at least ten (10) before the Return Date.

ORDERED, that answering papers, either in support of or opposition to the relief sought efiled on or before April 14, 2022 by 5 p.m. herein ("Answering Papers"), be served on the Liquidator so as to be received at least seven (7) RECEIVED NYSCEF: 03/04/2022
